- The competition is open to autistic children and adults only.
- The competition is only open to residents of the United Kingdom.
- Entries must arrive by 8 January 2023. Entries received after this date will not be included in the competition. The promoter will not be responsible for any entries that are not received for any reason, by the closing date, whether lost, delayed, corrupted or otherwise, and whether or not due to any technical difficulties or malfunctions.
- Entries cannot be returned to entrants.
- All entries must be accompanied by a valid entry form (above).
- The design must be an original and not a copy of previous designs.
- Children's competition applications must have given the age of the child at the time and consent from a parent or carer.
- The National Autistic Society reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if we have reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the rules.
- The prize is to have the winning design printed as a Christmas card by the National Autistic Society.
- The prize is non-transferable. No cash alternative will be offered.
- Each winner will also receive five packs of their design.
- The prize may change at any time.
- The decision of the judges is final - no correspondence will be entered into.
- Winners will be notified in April 2023 via email unless your contact preference is otherwise.
- The winner consents to providing their photograph in relation to promotion, PR and Social Media.
- The National Autistic Society reserves the right to display or promote entries when it feels it will help promote the charitable aims of the National Autistic Society.

- The copyright of the design will remain with you.
